Getting Ready

LSC is a place where I can learn about
science and have fun, too!



Arriving



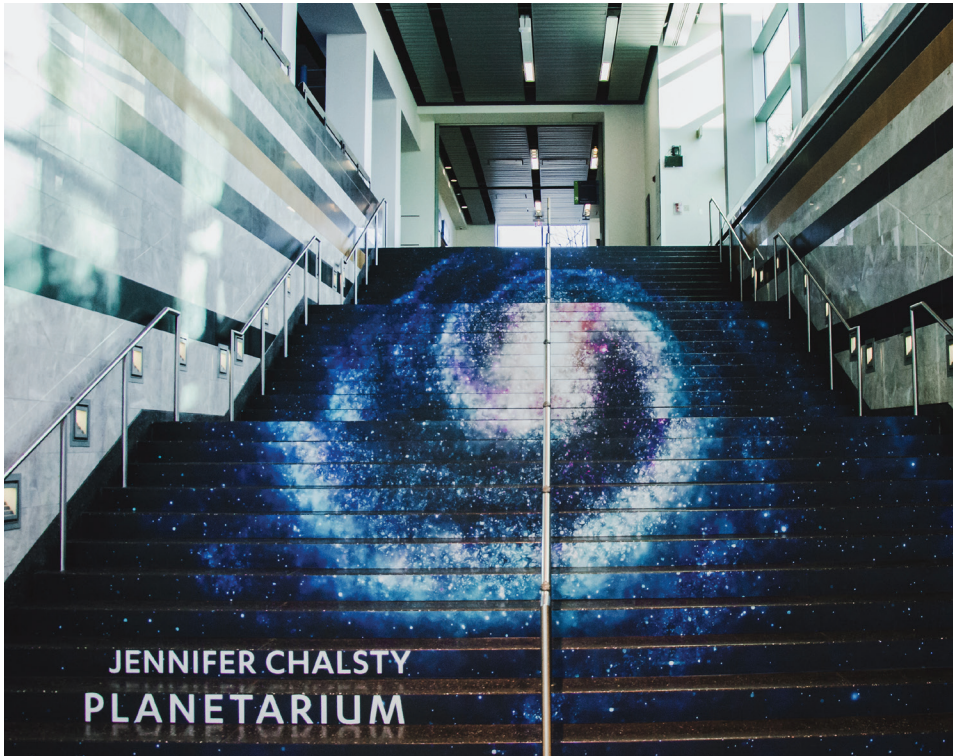
When we arrive at LSC, we will carefully go from the parking lot to the glass doors, then into the main lobby. It is important to stay with the person or group that is with me.

Once I go inside, I can say hello to the guard wearing a uniform. I can look up to see a big ball called a Hoberman Sphere. Sometimes it opens and closes quickly.

I might have to wait in a line before I explore. Sometimes there are a lot of people. It may be noisy.



Ready to Explore



There are four floors in the building with different activities.

I can walk up or down the stairs or take the elevator to get from one floor to another. I need to stay with the person or group I came with.

If I am hungry, I can go to the LSC café to buy food. I might smell the food that is being cooked in the LSC kitchen.

Helpers



LSC helpers wear name badges and shirts that say
“Liberty Science Center.”

If I need help or want to get information, I can ask an LSC helper.

If I need to use the bathroom, I can ask a helper to show me where it is.

There are helpers and bathrooms on every floor.

Sometimes, there is an LSC helper teaching about science. It’s a great way for me to learn something new. If I have a question, I can ask.

Animals and Climbing



On the third floor, there are **animals** like monkeys, snakes, and frogs. I can look through the glass and see where the animals live. LSC helpers may show a live animal outside its home. These helpers know how to keep everyone safe.

On the third floor, there is an exhibit called the **Infinity Climber**. People climb in the Infinity Climber. If I am more than 42 inches tall, I can climb in the Infinity Climber, too. If I climb in the Infinity Climber, I can look down and see the museum and people moving around below me.

Trains and a Tunnel



The Great Train Set has small trains running on tracks through model towns and landscapes. It is on the third floor.

While I am on the third floor, I can go into the **Touch Tunnel**. It is dark inside. I can crawl through the tunnel using my hands to feel the wall until I exit from the other side of the tunnel.

Big Fish and More



On the fourth floor, there is an exhibit called **Our Hudson Home**. It has fish, turtles, and other animals that live in the Hudson River. I can look through the glass of the fish tanks to see them.

Planetarium



LSC's planetarium is a big, special theater where I can learn about planets and stars. A helper will tell me about outer space and the sky.

Time to Go



When it's time to leave, I will go back to the first floor of the building. I might not have done everything at LSC, but I can ask to come back to visit again.

There is a gift shop that I can visit on my way out.

Before I leave, I can say goodbye to the LSC helpers I met during my visit.

When I am ready to leave, I need to be sure that I stay with the person or group who is with me to exit through the glass doors together.
